**Join us TODAY!** The Secretary of State will ONLY begin production of the EMS plates after receiving 1,500 requests (we are half way there).

What happens next ... once license plate production begins, an applicant is charged a \$27.00 fee for original issuance of their specialty plate (your original \$12.00 deposit will be applied to this \$27.00 fee). Each year when you renew your plates, a \$17.00 fee will be charged. Of that, \$15.00 is deposited into the EMS Memorial Scholarship & Training Fund.

**LICENSE PLATE NUMBERS GIVEN OUT ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS**

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Requests are available to the general public. An applicant does not need to be a licensed EMT or Paramedic in order to receive an EMS Plate.
